





 - Developed in 2013 and maintained by CRISP, Maryland’s Health Information Exchange
 - Averaged over 650 users per day during OE3

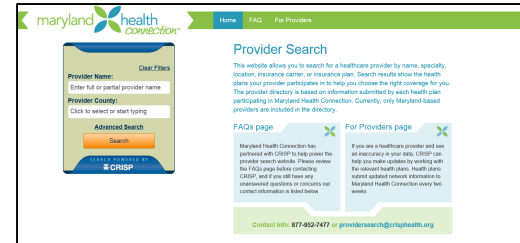
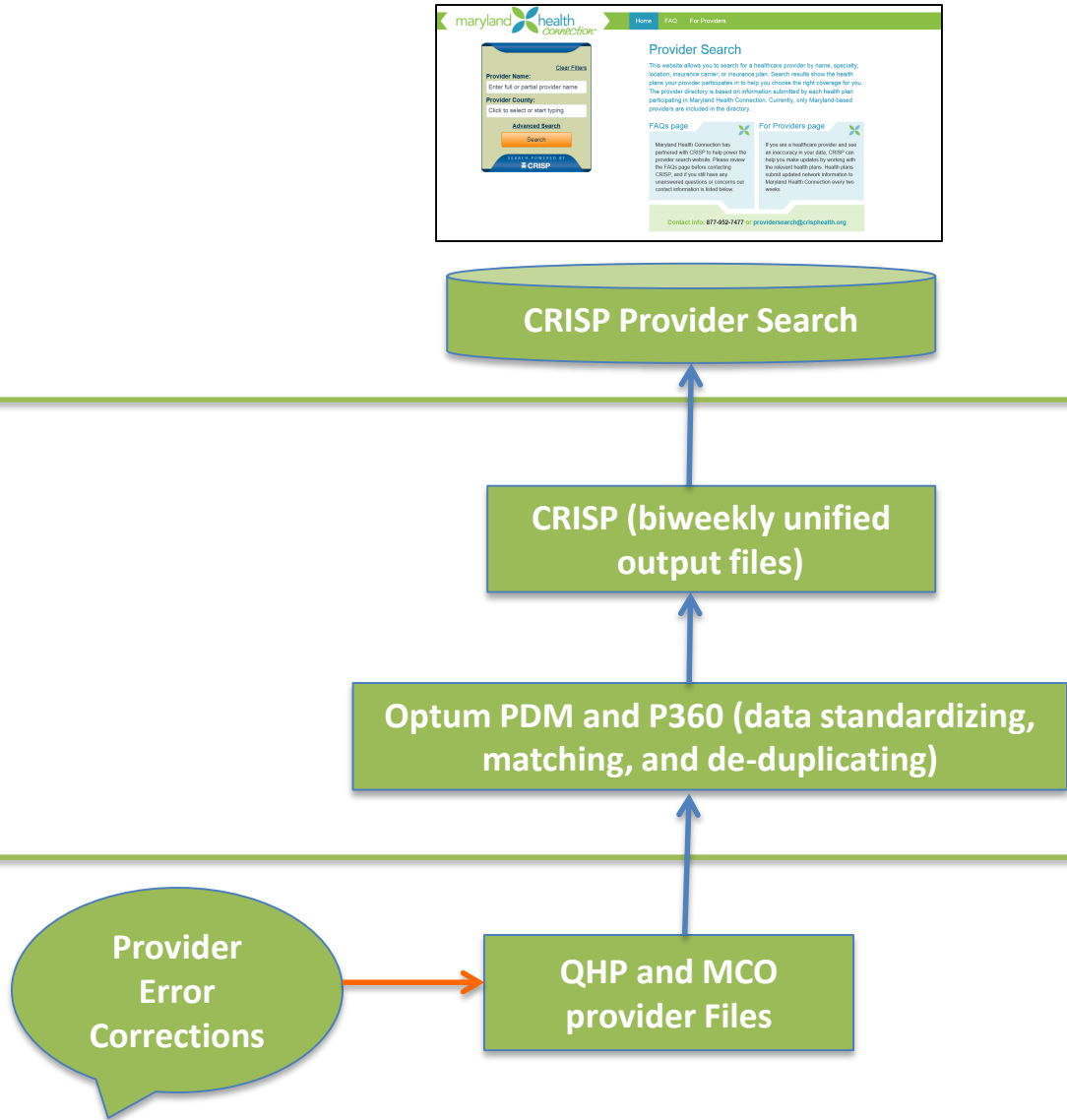
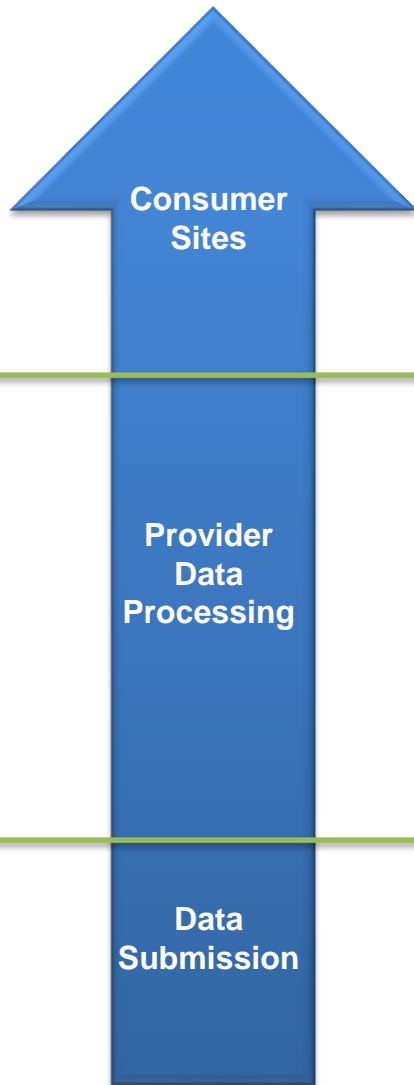

Background



- ✦ Provider Directory funded in FY2016 through MOU with Maryland Health Care Commission (MHCC)
 - Leverages MHCC's expertise to provide oversight and ensure CRISP performance
- ✦ More robust provider directory platform will be developed for Integrated Care Network
 - Will be designed to meet needs of multiple stakeholders
 - Cost to develop and maintain would be shared by multiple stakeholders
- ✦ HB1318 prohibits the MHBE Board from setting standards on carrier provider directories until 2019.

- ✦ FY 2017 budgeted amount is \$265,000 total funds (\$151,050 state funds)
- ✦ Proposed NTE is \$251,526 total funds (143,370 state funds)
- ✦ Continue to fund through MOU with MHCC
- ✦ Proposed MOU includes the following services:
