Kaiser Permanente	<p>As KP played a role in putting together many of the Affordability Workgroup's recommendation, we generally agree with the premise of the report and look forward to more discussion.</p> <p>A few call outs are as follow:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">· Young Adult Subsidy + Value Plans Generally -- Make sure the dollars to do the increased outreach, advertising, etc. is clearly allocated and communicated by MHBE· More research on short and long term impacts of Young Adult subsidy, including how the easy enrollment program will impact any potential Young Adult subsidy· For the chronic condition management – we urge MHBE look at risk adjustment payments when developing this proposal, and continue to keep carriers engaged to leverage what is already being done with population health management.
