## MARYLANDERS CAN GET FREE HELP ENROLLING IN HEALTH COVERAGE AS OPEN ENROLLMENT DEADLINE APPROACHES

STATEWIDE CALL-IN ENROLLMENT EVENTS OFFER HELP DEC. 5-15  
*Marylanders may enroll until Dec. 15 for 2021 private health plans*

BALTIMORE (Dec. 3, 2020) — Maryland Health Connection, the state’s health insurance marketplace where Marylanders can get financial help with their health coverage, will provide expert help to enroll by phone through statewide consumer assistance organizations Dec. 5-15. At these “Last Chance” phone events, navigators will provide free help to sign up for a health plan and understand coverage options and financial help.

Consumers also may enroll online at [MarylandHealthConnection.gov](http://MarylandHealthConnection.gov), through the free “Enroll MHC” mobile app, or by calling 1-855-642-8572 toll-free from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays. The call center has extended hours as the deadline approaches: Dec. 9, 10, & 11: 8 a.m.–10 p.m.; Dec. 12 & 13: 8 a.m.–4 p.m.; Dec. 14 & 15: 8 a.m.–10 p.m. Help is available in more than 200 languages.

The open enrollment period that ends on Dec. 15 is for private health and dental plans only. People who have coverage through Medicaid will receive a notice when it’s time to renew. Those who qualify for Medicaid may enroll any time of year.
