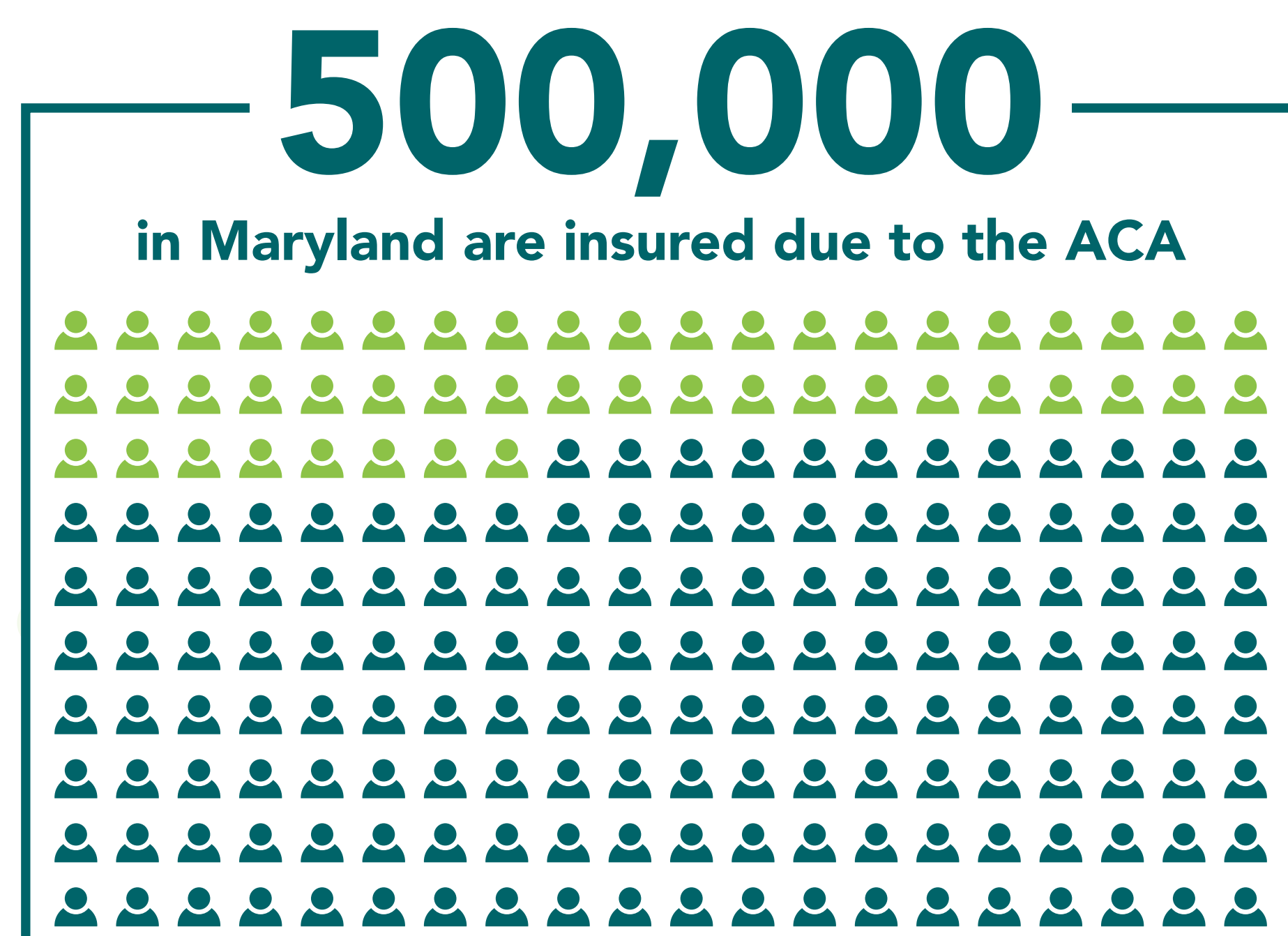

Black Marylanders

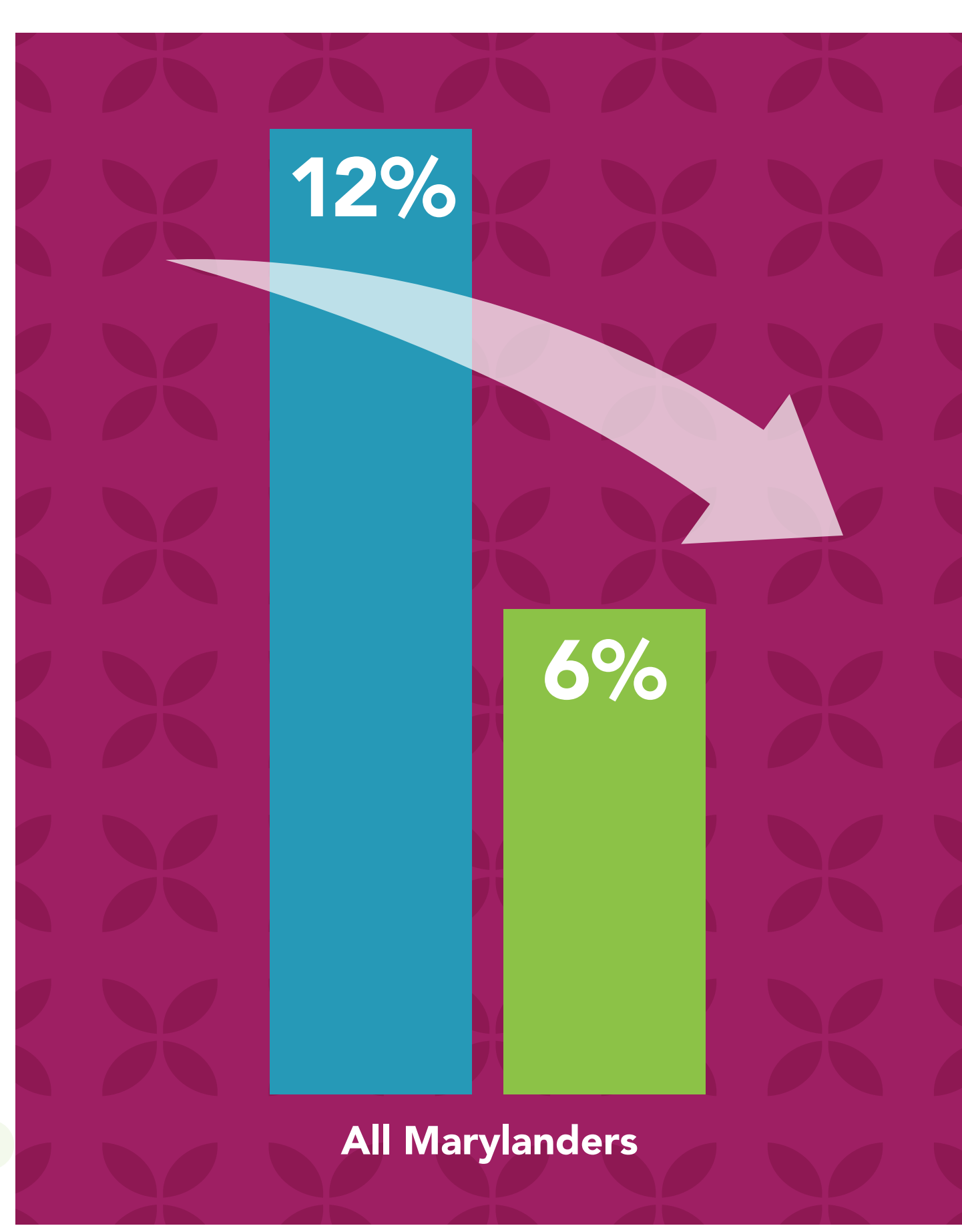

21% to 12%

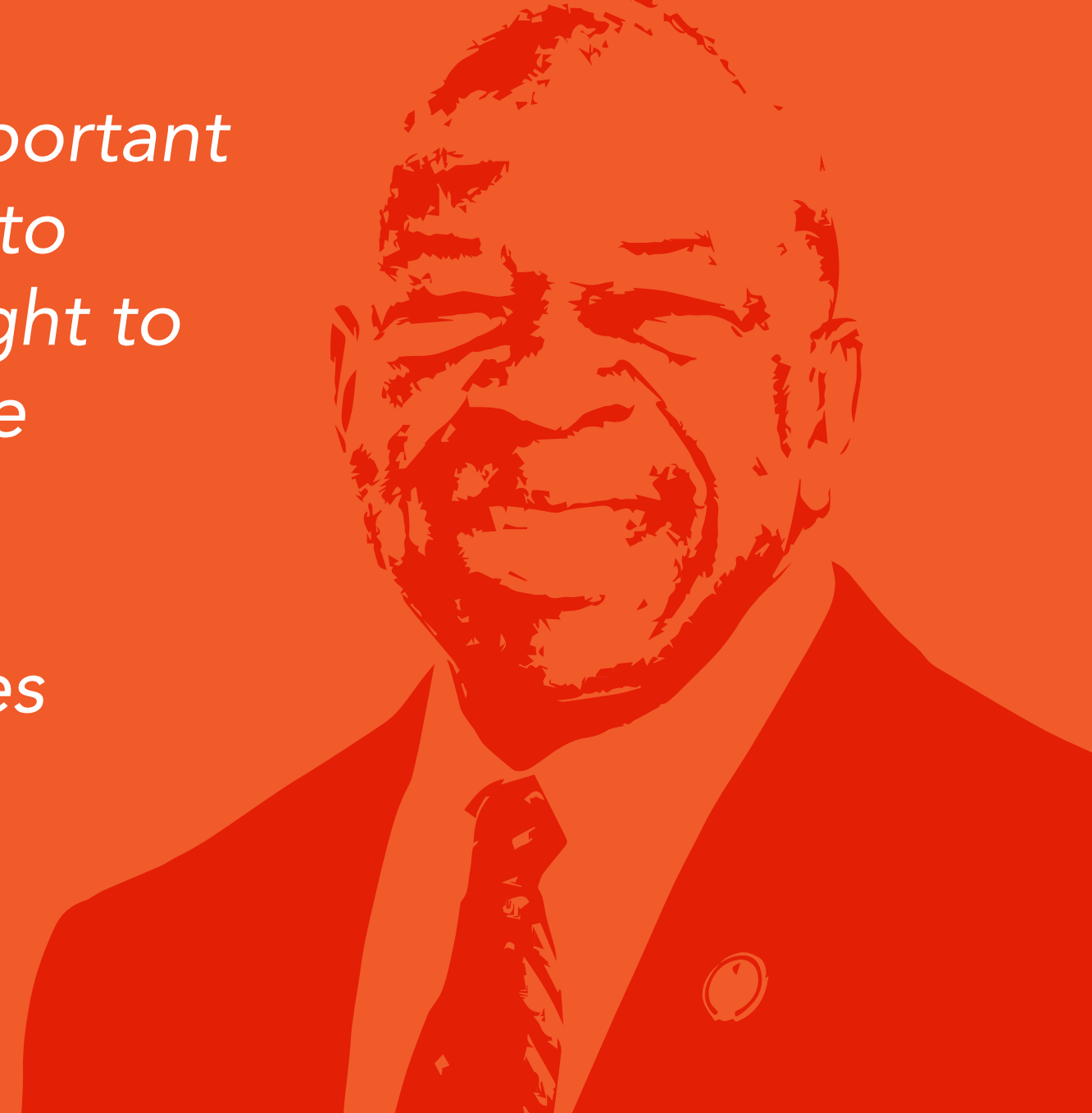


Making Coverage Affordable

An innovative state reinsurance program has helped drive down monthly premiums by more than 30% during the past three years.

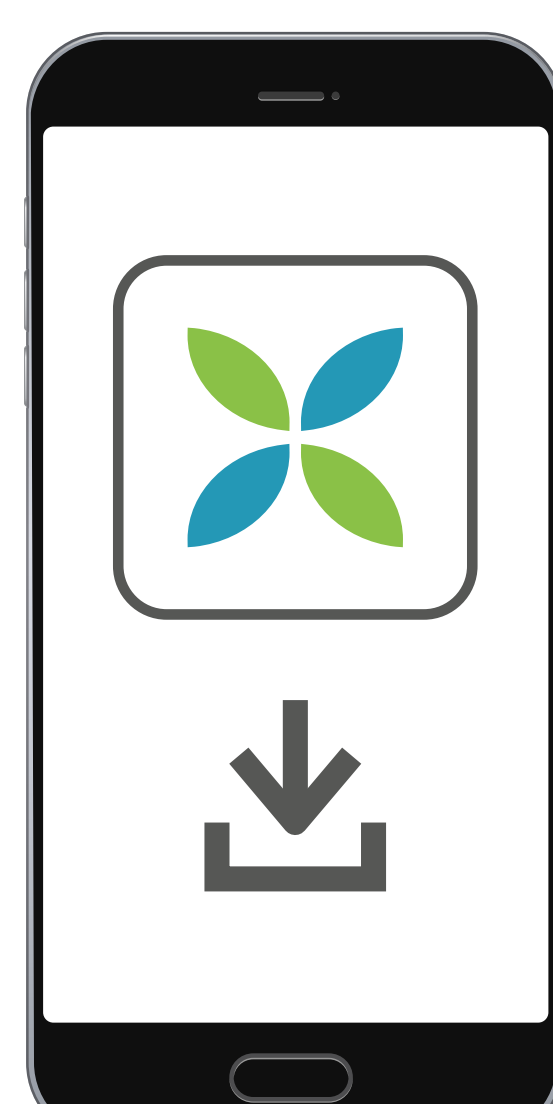

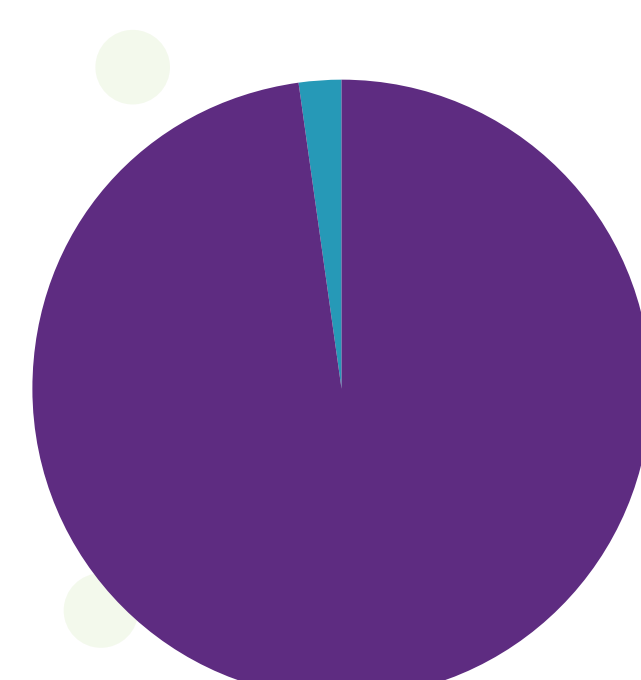
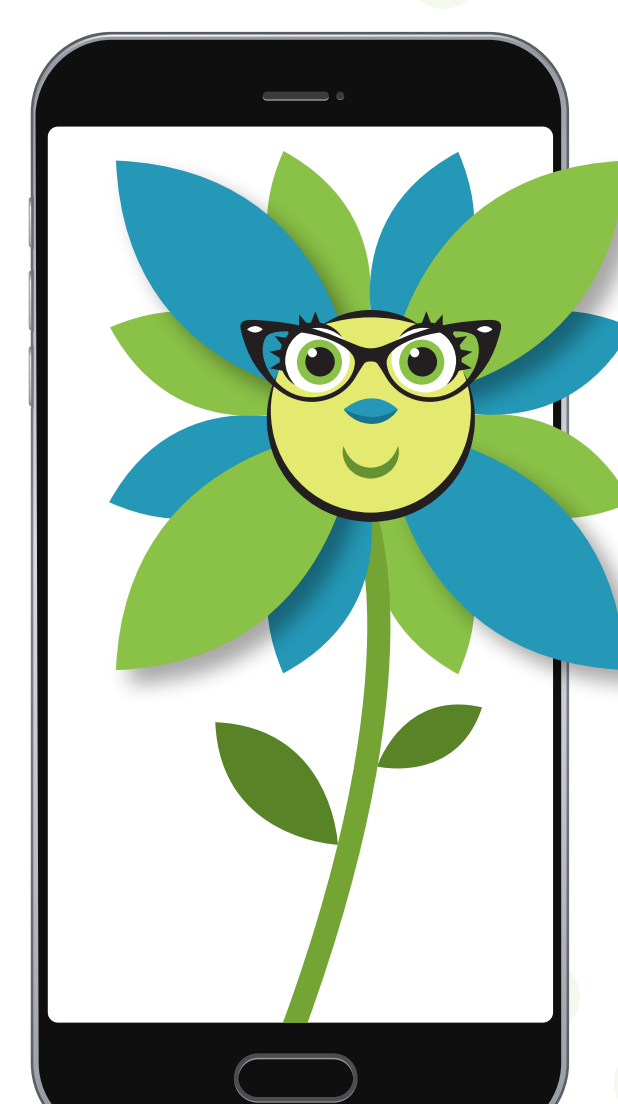
Increasing Access Through Technology
