Plan Management Updates

The following updates were shared:

- Reminders/target dates were provided for plan certification deliverables and key certification events.
- Changes to the plan shopping tile on MHC were confirmed. Key changes include a change to the value plan indicator and the separation of provider first and last name.
- Enrollment updates include:
 1. Failure to reconcile process will resume during this year's OE.
 2. A proposed 834 code for the Loss of Medicaid SEP was shared for carrier feedback.

Comments/Feedback from participants:

Carrier question – Can MHBE provide an impact list for those at risk of losing APTC during FTR process?

MHBE response – An internal discussion will need to happen to confirm if a list can be shared but its likely this request can be met for the second recheck batch.

Carrier question – Can MHBE provide more information on the FTR process, i.e. notices and any additional communication to consumers.

MHBE response – Notices and additional communication have not been finalized but we will share once they are.

Carriers question – Did the change to Loss of Medicaid SEP undergo a comment period? Wouldn't a comment period be necessary as this was initially introduced to the MHBE Board as a 90-day SEP?

MHBE response – We will confirm the comment period for the change in SEP.

Carrier question – Is the implementation date for the Loss of MEC SEP definite? The timeline will be tight to introduce a new 834 code.

Carrier question - Are additional changes to the provider directory forthcoming?

MHBE response – Yes, additional changes are planned but these won't take place until 2025 and carriers will be engaged.
